

# Influenza Vaccination Clinics Service Guide



## Ozcare Influenza Vaccination Clinics

Ozcare provides vaccination services across Queensland from its thirteen locally based offices. Ozcare will vaccinate your staff at Clinics operated in your workplace, at times convenient you, or staff can receive vaccination services from Clinics operated from one of Ozcare's local offices.

Ozcare will designate a qualified Nurse Immuniser to personally liaise with your service, to determine the best options and times for your Clinic and to ensure everything runs smoothly on the day.

Each Nurse Immuniser can vaccinate up to twenty people per hour, depending on the Clinic set up. In most instances, two Nurse Immunisers will attend each Clinic.

The best time to arrange your Clinic is from March to June to ensure immunity for the forthcoming flu season. Ozcare Flu Clinics in 2010 will commence in April (after Easter).

## Vaccination Options and Costs

Ozcare offers two types of vaccinations, an intra-dermal vaccine and intramuscular vaccine.

**Intantza**, the intra-dermal vaccination, will be provided at a cost of **\$27.00 per person**. Intanza has a much shorter needle and is delivered directly into the dermal layer of the skin. It is suitable for people between 18 and 59 years of age.

**Vaxigrip**, the intramuscular vaccination, will be provided at a cost of **\$25.00 per person**. It is suitable for people over 18. **Vaxigrip Junior** is available for children under 18 years of age.

Costs are inclusive of the vaccine, GST and the first 30 minutes of travel.

Monthly invoices will apply. Ozcare can invoice directly to the workplace or to a central office.

Ozcare travels extensively to provide Flu Clinics. In some rural and remote communities, it may be necessary to recover the cost of accommodation, flights, meals etc. These costs will be advised when Clinics are arranged. Travel time is charged at an hourly rate (\$80.00 per hour per Nurse Immuniser) plus 60 cents per km.

There is a minimum charge of six people per Clinic.

## Successful Workplace Clinics

Ozcare can provide staff education and a range of resources are available to ensure a successful Clinic on the day. If you have any questions about preparation for a Clinic, you may contact Ozcare at any time.

A range of reports on the outcomes of Influenza Clinics for the workplace can be provided to suit your human resource requirements.

## Safety

All Ozcare's Immunisers are endorsed by the Queensland Nursing Council and Ozcare has a Health Management Protocol approved by Queensland Health.

Additional information regarding vaccination options can be provided by Ozcare to help you make the right choice for your workplace.

The vaccine type will be determined prior to Clinics taking place.
